**Public Comments:**

**J. L. Steele** said, I live over on Dishong Mountain. Just out of curiosity, they ran a sewer line down there. . has there ever been any talk about putting a water line through there? I have spring water and its been tested and it's not good to drink. Everyone else has wells or springs. **Vice-Chairman Wallet** said, we would have to run

a line from Mile Hill Road along Route 22 where there are no customers to Dishong Mountain, so the cost would be astronomical. **Solicitor Barbin** said, the only other option would be to run it up from Johnstown and the cost of the pumping stations would be very expensive for the number of customers. **Chairman Baker** said, the sewer line was constructed by Waste Management. **Barbin** said, ordinarily that wouldn't have happened except Waste Management decided to spend 6 million dollars to construct it for their use from the landfill. **Steele** said, it's not mandatory to tap into the sewer system? **Barbin** said, that's correct. The Johnstown Redevelopment authority owns the line. **Manager Hirko** added, there were no public funds used for the construction of the sewer line. **Barbin** said, Waste Management needed the line in order not to have to truck their waste from the landfill to the sewage plant. The DCNR owns the majority of land along Dishong Mountain Road.

**Supervisor Eric Dreikorn** said, I am formally announcing my candidacy for District Magistrate. I know I've been in it for awhile but I just want to get it on record.
