Motion Wallet, second Dreikorn to adopt Ordinance # 188 incurring lease rental debt in the principal amount of \$3,135,000 to be evidence by its several guaranty (57%) of the \$5,500,000 principal amount Guaranteed Sewer Revenue Note of the Jackson-East Taylor Sewer Authority, to construct improvements to the Authority's sanitary sewer system; authorizing a Guaranty Agreement, evidencing such lease rental debt, by and among this Township and the Township of East Taylor, as several (not joint) guarantors, the Authority and the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority, as lender, further securing the note; pledging the full faith, credit and taxing power of this Township in support thereof; appointing a sinking fund depository; and authorizing related provisions. Vote-3 yes.

Motion Dreikorn, second Wallet to award bid to Matthew and Emilie Gibbons to purchase a property (Tax Map Number 34-007-134.1) located at 114 Meade Street from Jackson Township. Vote-3 yes.
