Public Comments:

Dave Tucker said, I live at 124 Adams Avenue and talking about the work that was done on the road out there through Merlo. . .I'm now getting water in my basement from what they done out there. They replaced some of our driveway and they didn't do a complete job on it. They said they would do it right and make it look right and it doesn't look right. It's two different colors of concrete and I have water in my basement. I kept trying to call them and they would no return my calls. **Vice Chairman Wallet** asked, have you contacted anyone at CPV? **Tucker** replied, no. . . just a Supervisor from Merlo. . I think his name was Bob. **Chairman Baker** said, we will forward your concerns to CPV. Dave Tucker submitted photos of flooding and damage to his house.

Rob Crynock said, I'm here in regards to this petition that was signed by local residents of Jackson Township. The petition is from residents of Gillen Lane, Blackburn Road and Adams Avenue concerning 2 water lines installed by CPV down the center of Gillen Lane, Blackburn Road and Adams Avenue from August to November of 2018. After post water line construction, property owners are dealing with uncontrolled stormwater runoff, unsafe driveway access, flooded basements and property damage. We are requesting that the issues be fixed regarding all damages by the CPV Water Line. Some of the people affected are 60-70 years old or even 80. There's actually erosion going in the back of their properties. Where there's a garden they had once, they can't because it's now a sinkhole. . .also down on the lower end in regards to the mudslide. I have photos of my house of the uncontrolled water issues that are flooding in his garage. I have never had any water issues in my basement and I'm getting flooded. We need drainage systems installed along there because the groundwater table was rose in regards to putting 2 12" and 24" water lines in there. I also have a message from CPV ventures, Jeff Ahrens from last Fall, that he knows there is a water issue. It has not been resolved and needs fixed. There should be a "punch list" with every construction company. They were supposed to talk about putting curbs in and that was cut. We didn't want it. There was a 6" perforated line on each side of the road but there's still percolation. . it just moved in another area so in regards to that water and the way the road is crowned, we are still having water issues. If we don't have it corrected in 30 days, we are going to take legal action. **Chairman Baker** said, noted. . your information was submitted. We will pass it along to CPV for them to take care of.

Doug Johnston said, I'm President of the Chickaree Ridgerunners. I'm here to give you are new website. . we changed in the past few years. The other issue is the washout on the road to our Snowmobile Club. The folks from the ball games park down there.


Announcements:
