

**SUPERVISOR'S MEETING
August 29, 2019**

The Jackson Township Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Jackson Township Municipal Building. Members present were Supervisors Bruce Baker, John Wallet and Eric Dreikorn along with Secretary/Treasurer/Manager Dave Hirko and Solicitor Bill Barbin. The meeting was called to order by Bruce Baker, Chairman, with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Board Roll Call was taken with all three Supervisors present.

PUBLIC HEARING

Solicitor Bill Barbin said, we have an Amendment to the Jackson Township Subdivision Ordinance that is to be considered by the Supervisors tonight. Prior to doing that, we advertised that we would hold a Public Hearing and the Supervisors may adopt the Amendment after the Public Hearing. The Amendment. . .we took all the sections that had been cut out of the old Subdivision Ordinance that Sutter changed to make us match Ebensburg and Cambria Township. He took all our regulations for Mobile Home Parks out, just cut that whole section out. The sections that you're going to put in the Subdivision Ordinance if you approve it tonight are the same sections that were in before Sutter removed them. We will be going back to how it was in 2004 so that George Burkey will have the ability to cite them for violations. Does anyone here have any comments? There were no public comments and the Public Hearing was closed.
