**Public Comments:**

**Vince Brisini** said, I live on the corner of Leidy Lane and Adams Avenue and I would like to talk about the Mariner II East Pipeline Project and the Adams Avenue access. For over a month I've been having fugitive emissions problems and not cleaning of the roads. I've been trying to work with them. I brought in a few photos in of what they left last Friday and called clean and then photos after I took my one gallon garden sprayer and cleaned the road. I've engaged the Dept. of Environmental Protection and contacted the other folks. I'm asking for some assistance from the Township that making sure that these folks wherever they are working in the Township. . . that they conduct themselves in a much more responsible fashion. Brisini also expressed concern about the heavy vehicles using the roads even if they were bonded. Brisini said, I would hope that you would communicate with them regarding these matters. **Chairman Baker** said, we will and we have been in touch with them but we'll keep on them.

**Dale Wix** said, this is a trivial thing compared to tearing up roads but it has to do with roads. We all love the Heritage Festival. .it's a great promotion and Wix Pix is glad to help promote it. . we have been for a number of years. For the last couple of years there's been a 5K Race which is really nifty and a lot of people enjoyed having it but this year probably 300 arrows were painted on the streets in Vinco. . white arrows that are probably 2 feet long and a foot wide going all sorts of directions. The morning of the race, the people who planned it did a really good job because they had signs at every intersection where there was to be a turn which sort of made the arrows on the road redundant. Also the morning of the race there were volunteers at every turn of the race. Adding insult to injury, the arrows are painted on the wrong side of the road. We learned as kids, you walk on the left side of the road facing traffic and the arrows are on the right side which is much more dangerous. The race lasts about 2 hours and these arrows last over a year. I made copies of photographs of the arrows. What I'm suggesting is getting a guy out on the road with a pressure sprayer and say. . do 20 a day. . get these things off our roads so they don't mess up the look of our neighborhood. The second thing is maybe some sort of an ordinance that says you can't go out and paint stuff on the roads for whatever event may be happening. I know everyone is excited about the race and it's a neat thing but it just got a little overboard on this.
