Solicitor Bill Barbin said, we had advertised another Ordinance for adoption which guarantees the Fords Corner Sewage Project debt. That Ordinance appeared in the newspaper on September 12, 2015.

Motion Wallet, second Baker to approve Ordinance # 178 authorizing the guaranteeing of a \$686,000. USDA Loan for the construction of the Fords Corner North Sewer Project. The vote was opened up for public comment and there were no comments. A vote was then taken. Vote-3 yes.
