

SUPERVISOR'S MEETING
October 8, 2015

The Jackson Township Supervisors held their regular meeting at 8:00 a.m. at the Jackson Township Municipal Building. Members present were Supervisors Bruce Baker, John Wallet and Eric Dreikorn along with Secretary-Treasurer / Manager Dave Hirko and Solicitor Bill Barbin. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Baker with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Manager Hirko said, we received a letter from the **Interfaith Community Food Pantry** about a donation.

New Business:

Theodora Kreitz of **Keller Engineers** gave a public presentation on the MS-4 Stormwater Management Permit and requirements for Jackson Township. **Kreitz** said, there are six Minimum Control Measures which include Public Education and Outreach on Stormwater Impacts, Public Involvement & Participation, Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control or Erosion & Sedimentation, Post-Construction Stormwater Management in New & Redevelopment Activities and Pollution Prevention & Good Housekeeping. The permit for Jackson Township was started in 2003 and is a requirement based on the Federal Clean Water Act handed down to the States. They determined the municipalities that needed to participate on Census data and developed an urbanized area map based on population density. The ultimate responsibility is not to pollute the waterways and stormwater does cause pollution because anything that is on the pavement of roads, etc. washes off. The 5 year permit will need to be done at the end of 2017 as needs to be renewed in 2018. The first permit required us to map outfalls while this permit requires you to map your entire collection system. The purpose of this is to find out or track where an illicit discharge is coming from. An illicit discharge is anything that enters the system that is not stormwater. Kreitz elaborated on each of the six Minimum Control Measures in detail and a time was available for any questions or comments from the public.
