ADDENDUM NO. 2 TO ORDINANCE NO. 89

JACKSON TOWNSHIP. CAMBRIA COUNTY. PENNSYLVANIA

AN ADDENDUM TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO 89 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING THE OFFICE OF TOVYNSIUP MANAGER ANDESTABLISHING POWERS AND DIJTIES OF THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER, SPECIFICALLY ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORITY OF THE MANAGER TO REVIEW AND APPROVE POLICE SCHEDULES AND TO ASSUME A ROLE AS DESIGNATED IN TOWNSHIP POLICY WITH REGARDS TO COMPLAINTS AND EMPLOYEE DISCIPLINE

WHEREAS, Ordinance No.89 was originally adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township on December 22,1993; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Jackson wish to amend Section Ordinance 89 to provide additional duties and responsibilities to the Manager.

AND NOW, this \_\_<sup>th</sup> day of \_\_\_\_\_, 200\_, it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Jackson as follows:

1. Section VI(C)(2) of Ordinance No.89 is hereby replaced and amended to read as follows:

“2. The Township manager shall not be responsible or in anyway involved in any day to day Police Department Operations or conduct of Official Police business. However, the Manager shall review and approve, in advance, all schedules for work, review and approve and payrolls, and shall act in a role as may be designated by the Supervisors, from time to time, in written policy in matters involving complaints or employee discipline. The manger shall not be responsible for certifying or verifying the accuracy of reports of time worked as submitted by the ranking Police Officer.”

2. Except to the extent modified herein, all other provisions of Ordinance No.89, as previously amended, are hereby reaffirmed arid remain in full force and effect.
