Ordinance No. 11

PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF A
BUILDING FOR TOWNSHIP PURPOSES.

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That a building for township purposes be erected on the following described parcel of land owned by Jackson Township:

All that certain lot or piece of land situate in the Township of Jackson, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a corner of the land of H. W. Storey, et ux., and the Munday heirs, on the Stone Pike; thence South 28° West 200 feet along the line of said Munday heirs; thence South 82° East 100 feet to a post; thence North 28° East 200 feet to the said pike; thence North 82° West 100 feet along the line of said pike to the place of beginning. In accordance with specifications now on file in the Office of the Township Secretary.

SECTION 2. That the Supervisors be and they hereby are authorized and directed to negotiate for a loan under the provisions of the Act of June 25, 1941, P. L. 159, as amended, in order to defray the cost of erecting said building.
