

ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS AND THE TERM FOR EACH MEMBER TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Municipality heretofore adopted Ordinance No. 49 on Sept. 12 __, 1980, which defined creation and establishment of a Planning Commission for the Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania and prescribed duties and powers conferred upon said Planning Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 49 entitled "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA" is amended to reduce the total number of members of the Planning Commission from the existing total of seven (7) members to a new total of five (5) members. Amended Section 2 shall read as follows:

Said Planning Commission shall consist of five (5) members to be appointed by the Supervisors of Jackson Township for terms of four (4) years each. Existing members shall serve out the remainder of their term unless a vacancy is created in their respective position by any method permitted by law. It is the intent of the Jackson Township Supervisors to have the five (5) members serve their terms on a staggered basis such that at least one (1) member is appointed/reappointed during each calendar year. In order to accomplish this staggered term, the Supervisors are

authorized to initially appoint/re-appoint a member for a period of less than four (4) years.

SECTION 2.

It is the intent of the municipality that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any section, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect to impair the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid part or parts.

SECTION 3.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as inconsistent only. The provisions of this Ordinance, so far as they are consistent with those Ordinances and regulations in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such prior Ordinances and regulations and not as new enactments.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately, or as soon as legally permissible and shall remain in effect unless and until subsequently appealed or amended.
