JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPERVISORS SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE REAL PROPERTY TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE YEAR 2010 AND THEREAFTER.

A. Jackson Township has previously established compensation for the real property tax collector by Ordinance No. 31 for the period beginning January 1, 1973.

B. Jackson Township wishes to maintain a stable rate of compensation consistent with the prior Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the compensation of the elected real property tax collector for Jackson Township real estate property tax millage is hereby set for the tax year beginning January 1, 2010, as follows:

- A. Compensation shall be in the amount of \$2.00 per parcel, collected and uncollected, and \$1.00 per record for updates and changes to addresses and/or names on the tax roll and submitted to the Township and County.
- B. Compensation shall be paid bi-weekly, upon compliance with job responsibilities, by the Jackson Township payroll clerk with appropriate withholdings.
- C. Jackson Township will reimburse its share of the cost of envelopes and postage.
- D. Jackson Township will pay one-half (1/2) cost of the tax duplicate and bond.
- E. Jackson Township shall provide space for a collection office at no charge.
- F. The Township reserves the right to adopt rules and regulations relating to performance of duties of the tax collector.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Jackson Township Supervisors held on the 12th day of February 2009; effective for the term of the elected real property tax collector beginning January 1, 2010.
