

ORDINANCE NO. ____
JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY,
PROVIDING A PROCEDURE FOR THE ESTABLISH OF RULES FOR
USERS OF TOWNSHIP FACILITIES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR VIOLATION.**

Whereas, Jackson Township has established parks and other public facilities for the use and enjoyment of residents and the general public, which is administered by the Jackson Township Recreation Commission, and,

Whereas, Jackson Township sponsors a Senior Citizens Community Center on township property which is administered by an executive board elected from among the persons using the center,

Whereas, there is from time to time a need to establish rules governing personal conduct at the facilities, so as to prevent one or more persons preventing other members of the public from fully enjoying the public facilities due to uncivil, discourteous, harmful or seriously annoying behavior.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted as follows;

1. The Jackson Township Recreation Commission and the Senior Citizens Center Executive Board are hereby authorized to adopt rules for the conduct of users of Jackson Township Parks and the Jackson Township Senior Citizens Center, and,
2. Rules Adopted by the Jackson Township Recreation Commission or Senior Citizens Center Executive Board shall be committed to writing and presented to the Township Supervisors for approval, modification or rejection at any public meeting of the Supervisors.
3. All such rules approved by the supervisors shall have full force and effect, only after posting in a conspicuous location on the park or at the Senior Citizens Center.

4. Violation of the any of the rules so adopted and posted shall constitute a violation of this ordinance.
5. Violators of the ordinance shall be prosecuted by non traffic citation filed at the District Magistrate's Office, by either the Township Manager or Township Codes Enforcement Official.
6. Persons convicted of a violation of the rule shall be sentenced to pa a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$600.00 for each separate offense plus the costs of prosecution.
