

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON SIGNIFYING THE DESIRE AND INTENTION OF THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF SAID TOWNSHIP TO CREATE A MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY KNOWN AS "JACKSON TOWNSHIP WATER AUTHORITY" SETTING FORTH THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND PROVIDING FOR THE NECESSARY NOTICES, REGISTRATION AND RECORDING OF SAID ARTICLES

Be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of the Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That it is the desire of the Supervisors of the Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and the said Supervisors hereby signify their intention to organize an authority under the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945" and its amendments and supplements.

Section 2. That in pursuance of said desire and intention and in conformity with the terms and provisions of said law, the proposed Articles of Incorporation are set forth as follows:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA:

In compliance with the requirements of the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945" approved May 2, 1945, P. L. 382, and its amendments and supplements, the Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, desiring and intending to incorporate a body corporate and politic known as an "Authority", does hereby certify:

(a) The name of the authority shall be

"JACKSON TOWNSHIP WATER AUTHORITY"

(b) Said Jackson Township Water Authority shall be formed under the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945", approved May 2, 1945, P. L. 382, and its amendments and supplements, for the purposes and powers conferred upon

bodies corporate created under said Act as amended without limitations as to other powers generally named in the said Act of Assembly creating such a body corporate and shall have authority to acquire, hold, construct, operate and lease, within the capacity of lessor or lessee, water works, water supply works, water distribution systems, pipe lines, reservoirs, wells and pumping stations for the purpose of rendering water service in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and to enter into contracts to supply water and other services to other municipalities and individuals that are beyond the corporate limits of Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

(c) No other authority has been organized under the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1935", approved June 28, 1935, P. L. 463, and its amendments and supplements, or under the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945" for the Township of Jackson.

(d) The name of the incorporating municipality, together with the names and addresses of its municipal authorities, are as follows:

(e) The names, addresses and terms of office of the first members of the Board of said Authority are:

(f) That said Authority shall have an existence for the term of fifty (50) years.

Section 3. The proposed Articles of Incorporation of said Authority shall be executed by and on behalf of the Township of Jackson by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the seal of said Township shall be thereto affixed, attested by the Secretary and filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth. The Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be published the notice of intention to file the Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of the Commonwealth as required by the aforementioned law.
