Ordinance No. 20

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR
JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That a Township Planning Commission be and hereby is created and established in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. Said Planning Commission shall consist of seven members to be appointed by the Supervisors of Jackson Township for terms of four years each, except that the terms of the members first appointed shall be so fixed that two members shall be appointed for four years, two for three years, two for two years and one for one year.

SECTION 3. The names, addresses and terms of office of the first members of the Planning Commission hereby appointed are as follows:

SECTION 4. Said Planning Commission shall perform all the duties and may exercise all the powers conferred upon Second-Class Township Planning Commissions by law.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
