Ordinance No. 26

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A RECREATION BOARD FOR  
JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That a Township Recreation Board be and hereby is created and established in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. Said Recreation Board shall consist of seven members to be appointed by the Supervisors of Jackson Township for terms of five years each, except that the terms of the members first appointed shall be so fixed that two members shall be appointed for five years, two for four years, one for three years, one for two years and one for one year.

SECTION 3. The names, addresses and terms of office of the first members of the Recreation Board hereby appointed are as follows:

SECTION 4. Said Recreation Board shall perform all the duties and may exercise all the powers conferred upon Second-Class Township Recreation Boards by law.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
