ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF A
PARCEL OF LAND IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, TO JOSEPH R. FLETCHER AND SHIRLEY
ANN FLETCHER, HUSBAND AND WIFE.

The Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains
as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Township of Jackson grant and convey to Joseph
R. Fletcher and Shirley Ann Fletcher, husband and wife, for the sum of Two
Hundred and 00/100 (\$200.00) Dollars the following described parcel of land:

ALL that certain lot of land situate in Jackson Township,
Cambria County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of the
William Penn Highway with a private road leading to prop-
erty of Blaine Teeter; thence in an Easterly direction
along said William Penn Highway 50 feet to another iron
pin; thence in a Southerly direction 100 feet to another
iron pin; thence in a Westerly direction 50 feet to an-
other iron pin at the above mentioned private road lead-
ing to Blaine Teeter's; thence in a Northerly direction
along said private road 100 feet to an iron pin, the
place of beginning and containing 5,000 square feet,
more or less.

EXCEPTING and RESERVING, however, all merchantable
coal underlying said lot and the mining rights and privi-
leges thereto belonging as conveyed by former grantors.

BEING the same premises title to which became vested
in the Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township, their
successors and assigns by deed of Benjamin F. Ford, et ux.,
dated April 29, 1919, and recorded in Deed Book Volume 310
at page 21.

SECTION 2. That the proper officers of the Board of Supervisors of
Jackson Township be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute on
behalf of Jackson Township all necessary documents to grant and convey said
premises as aforesaid.
