Ordinance # 3

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE OR REFUSE
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

The Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private property, any garbage, offal, carcass, putrid matter or other offensive or unwholesome matter, or cast the same upon an lot or piece of ground within the Township, or upon the shores or margin of any stream or body of water, or into any sewer inlet or upon any sidewalk in the Township. Nor may any person, firm or corporation use or permit to be used any spot or place within the Township as a public or private dump for garbage, refuse or rubbish.

SECTION 2.

Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.
