Ordinance # 58

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR OPENING AND OR MAJOR ALTERATIONS TO  
DRIVEWAYS ON TO TOWNSHIP ROADS OR STREETS.

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

Application must be made to the township on the forms as required by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for all new and or major alterations to existing driveways.

- a) A fee as established by the Pennsylvania Department Of Transportation shall accompany the application.
- b) Upon review and approval of the Township Supervisors a permit shall be issued.

SECTION 2.

Any person or persons who shall violate this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for each offense, and cost of prosecution and all necessary restoration. (State Highway Law (P.L. 531, No 117) Section 420.)

SECTION 3.

All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
