ORDINANCE NO. 6

GRANTING THE RIGHT TO JACKSON TOWNSHIP
WATER AUTHORITY TO LAY MAINS AND
REPLACE WATER LINES IN PUBLIC ROADS

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That Jackson Township Water Authority be and hereby granted the right to lay, maintain and operate water lines and mains together with appurtenances thereto in the public roads, streets and alleys of Jackson Township, and the right at all times in the future to repair, replace and inspect said water lines and mains and appurtenances thereto, and for said purposes to make all necessary excavations in the public roads, streets and alleys of Jackson Township, but the same shall be done with due and reasonable dispatch and with the least practicable interference with the rights and convenience of the public and individuals; provided, however, that said Authority shall restore all roads, streets and alleys when excavated by it to their original conditions.

SECTION 2. In laying down water lines and mains and appurtenances thereto the said Jackson Township Water Authority shall conform to all reasonable regulations which are or may be prescribed by the Township of Jackson and shall not interfere with, or injure any drains or sewers of the Township.

SECTION 3. The rights and privileges herein granted are upon the express condition that Jackson Township Water Authority shall indemnify and save harmless the Township of Jackson from all damages which may be awarded against said Township in favor of any person or persons, corporation or corporations, resulting from any act or thing done by said Authority by virtue of the authority and consent herein granted.
