Ordinance # 8

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS, CUSTODIANS AND KEEPERS OF
LICENSED DOGS FROM ALLOWING SUCH DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE, AND
PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

The Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful for the owner, custodian or keeper of any dog, bearing the current license tag, to allow such dog to run at large at any time, either upon any of the streets, alleys, roads or public grounds in the Township of Jackson, or upon the property of another than the owner, custodian, or keeper of such dog, unless accompanied by and under the immediate control of such owner, custodian or keeper.

SECTION 2

Any owner, custodian or keeper of any dog who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
