RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN FORMATION OF AN  
ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR MAINLINE COMMUNICATIONS  
SYSTEM AND APPOINTMENT OF A REPRESENTATIVE  
TO SUCH ADVISORY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, law enforcement constitutes an area of municipal services vital to the citizens of Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, an efficient communications system is a key element in providing effective law enforcement services to the citizens of said Jackson Township;

WHEREAS, as elected officials of Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, we recognize the benefits of the existing Mainline Area Communications System as the basis for effective law enforcement services to our citizens; and

WHEREAS, as the elected officials of said Jackson Township, we also recognize the value of municipal cooperation in such vital services to our citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Supervisors of Jackson Township hereby resolve as follows:

1. That Jackson Township participate, with other interested municipalities, in the formation of an Advisory Council for the purpose of planning, developing and administering the Mainline Communications System;
2. That Wayne Horner, a duly elected Supervisor of Jackson Township, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to act as the representative of Jackson Township in the formation of such an Advisory Council.
