Resolution of the Township of Jackson,  
County of Cambria, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of June at a regularly scheduled public meeting of the Jackson Township Supervisors.

Whereas, Jackson Township Supervisors have examined circumstances surrounding the operation of the a local liquor establishment known as the Pit Stop located at 3840 William Penn Highway SR 271 (Cambria County tax Map No. 34-027-107.002) near the intersection SR 0022 a limited access highway, relating to that establishment providing musical entertainment and the noise and potential interruption to neighbors; and

Whereas, the township has been informed that the liquor establishment has been cited for noise contrary to rules of the PLCB, and found the noise involved to be reasonable within the circumstances for the neighborhood; and

Whereas, the township has adopted an updated nuisance ordinance, Ordinance No. 169 on June 9, 2011, which contains provisions for enforcement against anyone in the township responsible for unreasonable noise.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Jackson Township Supervisors authorize and approve the filing of a petition with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board for exemption from the Board's regulation (40 Pa Code §5.32 (a)) regarding amplified music being heard off the licensed premises as to the facility known as the Pit Stop, located at 3840 William Penn Ave, Cambria County Tax map # 34-027-107.002, it being the townships intention to enforce its nuisance ordinance with respect to noise at that location and direct appropriate township officials to prepare execute and file the same.
