

RESOLUTION 33-89  
OF THE  
JACKSON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Laurel Run Watershed in Jackson Township, Cambria County, represents a unique, natural resource and value to the community, containing unique aesthetic, historical environmental and natural values, and

WHEREAS, the Laurel Run contains one of the last, native brook trout populations in the Greater Johnstown area, and

WHEREAS, the surface mining in the watershed would result in the degradation of the high quality cold water fishery present in Laurel Run, and

WHEREAS, destruction by surface mining of the Laurel Run Watershed would significantly reduce the quality of life present in Jackson Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jackson Township Supervisors support, endorse and co-sponsor the attached application of the Committee to Preserve Rager Mountain to the Pennsylvania Environmental Quality Board to designate the Laurel Run Watershed as an area unsuitable for surface mining.
