

**RESOLUTION
OF THE
JACKSON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**

MADE this _____ day of March, 2006, at a duly advertised public meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township, at which a quorum was present.

WHEREAS, The Township Supervisors have determined that employees and persons operating motor vehicles utilizing township insurance may not in all circumstances be utilizing seat belts as required by law ; and

WHEREAS, the lack of use of seatbelts is likely to aggravate injuries to persons in the event of accidents and eventually result in an increase in insurance premiums and costs to the township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township hereby declare the foregoing policy:

1. The use of seatbelts in all vehicles covered by the Township insurance is mandatory.
2. Failure to utilize seatbelts in vehicles covered by township insurance will hereinafter, result in the township terminating the authority of the person failing to drive or travel in the vehicle covered by township insurance.
3. The Township Manager shall upon receipt of information take action to notify affected person, in writing, of their prohibition to drive or travel in township insured vehicles.
4. The Manager shall report any such actions taken to the Supervisors.
5. Any person aggrieved by such a determination of the Township Manager may within 30 days of such notification by the manager may request a hearing before the Board of Supervisors.
6. The Township Supervisors reserve the right to take other appropriate action to ensure that all persons driving or traveling in township insured vehicles utilize seatbelts as prescribed by law.
