1. Pashek Associates 2007-2008 Matching Funds Grant Application submitted to DCNR for \$125,000.00. Grant includes a 2-phase project. First phase to include restrooms/sewer at Mitchell Park, 2 pavilions, concrete pads, asphalt, charcoal grills, and underground electric. Second Phase will include applying for more funding.
2. Fence Crown for Mitchell Park arrived but did not include the wire ties.
3. Central Cambria Midget Football League – a letter was sent to Betty Smith giving permission to use Leidy Park
4. Bio-Diversity Project at Leidy Park – Planting will be held May 26
5. Playground Equipment – bids are being accepted for labor work
6. Central Cambria Recreation Map – Coalition meeting May 10; requesting recreation sites be marked on the map
7. Grass Cutting – Township purchased a new mower from Ray's in Summerhill.
